Family of the Week – Jonathan & Althea

Dear CMF Family,

The homeschool schedule has solidified into something manageable on most days. It often leaves me completely exhausted long before the end of the day, but I see slow progress which gives me hope for a lighter burden before long. Isaiah is learning independence, and he is learning to control his attitude. This alone is a huge help!

Translation and all related activities continue slowly forward. Jonathan is thankful for the chance to discuss Biblical terms and concepts with our translators in the studio.

Translation is not always a straightforward task. For example, the first verse in the Bible caused them much discussion this week. "God created the heavens and the earth?" Verdiya has a variety of words to choose from, meaning "dirt," "ground," "place," and "world." Which word might fit the concept "earth" best in this sentence?

Another quandary in verses 11-12 still stumps them. "Let the land produce... trees that bear fruit with seed in it." While Verdiya has a name for each specific kind of fruit (apples, bananas, apricots, quince, etc.), they don't seem to have a word that encompasses "fruit" in general.

Please pray with us that God will fill our relationships with his light and peace.
