Deb, Allison, Vanessa, and I had the privilege of attending the Kingdom Connect Conference in Switzerland. Before the conference we did some sightseeing and visited some of the Anabaptist historical sites. The mountains were amazing, reminding us of the majesty of the God we serve. Visiting those places where the early Anabaptists were imprisoned, tortured, and gave their lives for their faith was very moving and challenging.

The conference was so encouraging.
