Dear CMF Family,

There are no words to express what your support through this week has meant, both to us and to the fellowship of national believers to which Betsam belongs. Betsam has begun to listen to counsel against her choice, and seems to have finally entered the battle with her own conscience. For now, that is where the situation stands, and we continue to fast and pray for complete victory for her, that she will flee evil while she still can.

We plan to attend her brother's wedding (he and his fiancée are both believers) in two weeks. We are praying that the celebration can be complete rejoicing, that we won't be crying over Betsam's hard heart when we want to be rejoicing with her brother.

There is a very demonic feel to all of this (particulars are too long for this note). It is definitely an attack on Betsam and on her church, but it also feels like a direct attack on the work here in Tarr. Betsam has invested heavily here at different times over the past year. We know that Resurrection power is at work, and we know it will bear fruit some day, but oh, how we long for Betsam to be with us in it as it unfolds!

Jonathan and I have traveled this weekend to a small service celebrating the completion of the Word in the local Arabic dialect (language spoken across the country). It is a *huge* honor to be invited, especially since we were not involved in that project. We have left the five children at home alone with emergency contacts in place and many prayers for their protection, and ours, as we are separated.
